Fact: yet today, there are difficulties damping collaboration between industry and academia:

- on the industry side, it is essentially a question of reliability, commitment by the RO, technology readiness of what is being offered, bureaucracy
- on the academia side, it is a matter of motivation



Whatever trick/approach is being proposed to improve the situation is most welcome

MAIN CONCERN on EasyAccess: Turning public investment into benefit/profit of a single, private enterprise at no cost

The focus shall be on:

• the compilation of the catalogue



• the adoption of an incentive scheme, more important here since the return will possibly be by Joint Development Actions involving directly the researchers.

MAIN INTEREST: use it as mechanism to promote the exploitation of tech's with LOW READINESS LEVEL, that would otherwise require significant investment by the PRO to get to level possibly interesting for a company.

Companies will not pay for the access but for the development

Complementary issues:

- particularly attractive for spin-off's
- · compare Easy vs public domani
