# SE - Catalogue Consistency

- All VOs have a problem with maintaining consistency between the replicas registered in their catalogues and the physical files on SEs.
- Some VOs have their own solutions
- Querying LFC and/or SEs file at a time is very inefficient, affects the performance for others, and will not scale.
- We should discuss the scope for efficient methods, possibly in common.
- Bring together VOs and SE implementors at a future meeting
