Tomorrow: funding bodies and libraries contribute to the consortium, which pays centrally for the peerreview service. Articles free to read for everyone.


10M€/year price tag. Today a single journal costs globally up to 5M€/year








Distribution of HEP articles by country, average 2005 - 2006

WWW based booking

- Agreed that it is technically possible and should be introduced
- It can not be on 100% of beds as some visitors do not have credit cards needed in obligatory field of WWW interface and block reservations
- Abuses should be limited by credit card guarantee and fees for late cancellations/modifications (details to be discussed)
- In case of cancellations forced by official changes of schedule, the facility of payment of cancellation fees by team leader account should be available
- WWW reservations will apply to fixed % of beds. Initial % can be determined from experimental number of credit card users in the past.
- Ultimately the WWW booking delay should be negligible (at start up \sim 3 days delays are possible)
- Old non-WWW booking will still work in parallel for remaining beds



New Office Space



Council agreed on the extension of building 40 in its last meeting. The new building would have three levels. There are two variants:

Car Sharing



In the PH division there are currently available:

113 logo cars and 148 unmarked cars

current car usage \sim 1 hour/day time sharing could increase this pilot exercise: 30 cars equipped with GPS + lock system possible cost increase per equipped car \sim 50 %, will increase all rental costs All cars of a user group can be registered under the name of a single person. He has to give a list of cars to M. Ducastel at the beginning of the year. The corresponing vignettes are then handed out.

Conclusions of the Task Force on the Introduction of an Ombudsperson at CERN:

- Increase of productivity → better motivation and less sick leave
- Cost reduction → less time spent on appeals and less money on tribunals
- Preventive action → issues resolved through informal advice/ mediation

CERN Users Office



The number of CERN users has increased from 6400 at the end of 2001 to 8700 in October 2007.
