This document describes the details of the OpenStack@CERN event for the Swiss and Rhone-Alpes OpenStack user group meetup.

Getting to CERN

CERN is located on the Swiss/French border near Meyrin, Geneva. Details are at <http://home.web.cern.ch/directions>.

If you arrive by tram, the reception building 33 is next to the tram stop.

If you arrive by car, please park by building 33 and collect an access card for entry onto the site. Parking can be found through the entrance.

If you are arriving on Thursday evening and staying at the hostel, please collect your badge from building 33. The hostel location is shown below. You can get dinner and breakfast in the Restaurant.

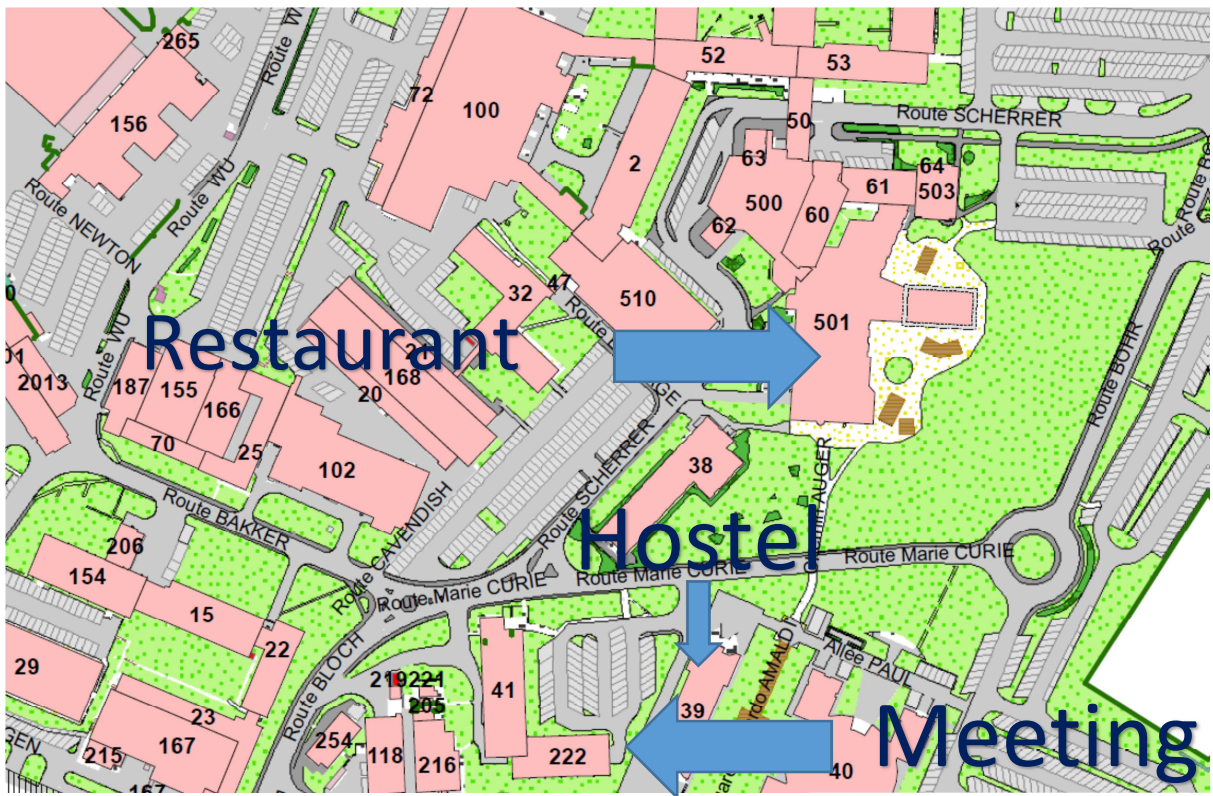
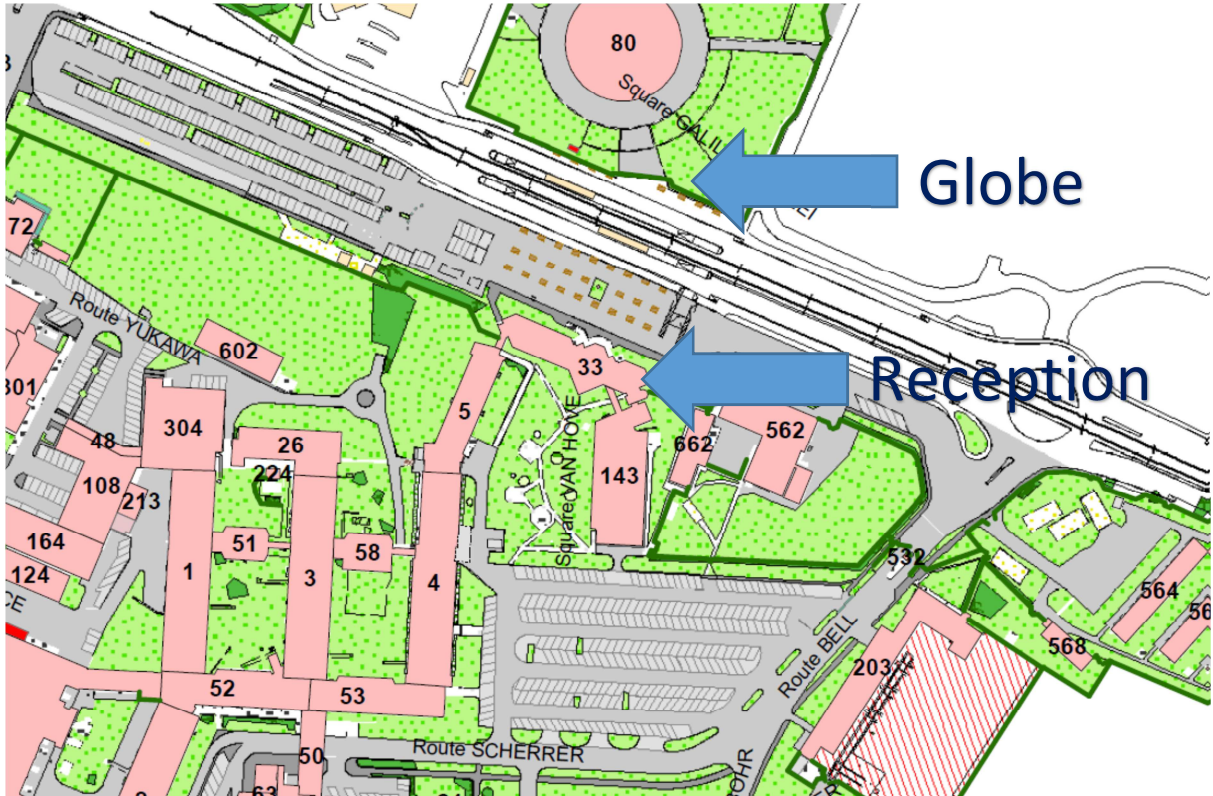
Orientation

The key places for the day are as follows

- The building 33 is the CERN reception. You can access this without an access badge. At building 33, there will be a desk to give you an access badge. During the morning, this will be the place to meet with your guides.



- The Globe of Innovation is easy to spot. Lots of interesting buttons to push at any time and a movie about the LHC is shown every 30 minutes. In English: 9:15, 10:15, ..., 15:15, 16:15 and in French: 9:45, 10:45, ..., 15:45, 16:45. This is free format and there is no guide so you can schedule your own time. - The CERN Microcosm exhibit (next to the reception) allows you to explore the mysteries of the universe at http://outreach.web.cern.ch/outreach/expos_cern/microcosm.html. This can be visited at any time during the day and is free format so there will be no guide.
- CERN Shop is a good place to get souvenirs, pop-up books, t-shirts, mugs and helmets. This is located next to the reception area in building 33.

- Key places
 - o Building 33 reception – where you arrive and there will be a desk with the access cards
 - o Filtration Plant – building 222 – where the meeting is at 14h00
 - o Restaurant 1 – lunch and post meeting social event. They accept swiss francs and euros.



Underground Visit

For those who have scheduled an underground visit to ATLAS, please note the following safety rules which must be complied with. These rules are mandatory and you will not be able to get underground if these are not followed.

- closed, flat or block-heeled shoes are required for the site visits and helmets will be provided
- access to underground areas is not authorized for pacemaker wearers nor pregnant women
- access to underground areas is not authorized for people under 16
- no laptop bags can be taken underground, cameras are permitted

You will have been contacted with the timeslot for your visit. Please arrange to be in building 33 15 minutes before the time slot. Visits cannot be rescheduled so latecomers will miss the opportunity. There is a guide for this visit and all people must be within the group.

3-D Film

There is also a slot for seeing a 3-D film which has been allocated to each of you doing an underground visit. For those who do not have an underground visit immediately before, please be at the reception in building 33 15 minutes before the time slot. The film slots cannot be rescheduled so latecomers will miss the opportunity. There is a guide for this visit and all people must be within the group.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I leave luggage at the reception in building 33?

A: You can register your device in advance of coming to CERN (see <https://indico.cern.ch/internalPage.py?pageld=0&confld=273593>). Alternatively, when you arrive on site, if you open up a browser, you'll be given a form to fill out.

Q: Is smoking permitted on site ?

A: Smoking is prohibited throughout the Organization's sites, but you may smoke outside buildings, except in areas where it would pose a fire hazard.
