Changes -> UMD-preview

- Move the management of the EMI repositories under the UMD
 - UMD-preview:
 - repositories
 - Will preserve all the EMI repos characteristics
 - » Updated monthly from PTs individual repos
 - » No EPEL packages
 - » Source packages -> repos in [AppDb](#)
 - » Third-party packages - repos in [AppDb](#)
 - New:
 - » management of repos - *using the UMD software provisioning workflow*
 - » A team of people instead of a single person
 - Web-pages
 - New pages - under the EGI-repository - <http://repository.egi.eu/>
 - » Automatically created *through the UMD software provisioning workflow*
 - » Collecting information from the individual releases notes
 - Old pages, EMI products & updates, will be updated with links

- **Migration completely transparent to the sites**
 - New *emi-release* package with new repositories
 - Technical details are discussed & agreed this month
 - A proper announcement will be made (broadcast)
 - timeline would be **~6 month** since the announcement

Conclusion

- UMD repositories:
 - UMD preview
 - as released by product teams
 - UMD production
 - full staged rollout process, highly suggested to be used by production sites
 - EMI repositories – will be freezed
