1 - CERN Document Server

- All particle physics literature since 1950
- And related areas documents:
 - Astrophysics, Mathematics, Life at CERN...
- 550,000 documents in more than 200 collections
- 220,000 fulltext files (preprints, photos, theses...)
- Originally developed on top of Aleph 300 in 1994
- Now free software (CDSware: http://cdsware.cern.ch) fully ALEPH independent.

2 - Multimedia Documents in CDS Description

- More than 10 multimedia collections.
 - Videoclips, pictures, objects, slides, posters...

2 - Multimedia Documents in CDS Description

- Data formats + Services
 - Pictures:
 - Automatic thumbnail creation (gif)
 - Several sizes/resolutions/conversions proposed (original in jpeg)
 - Example
 - Videoclips
 - Manual thumbnail creation (gif)
 - Proposed format Real Media (.rm)
 - Example
- Metadata format
 - Internal representation: MARC21
 - Several possible output formats
 - Photo Example
 - Videoclip <u>Example</u>

2 - Multimedia Documents in CDS Acquisition


- Web Submission form (CDS Submit)
 - Metadata collection
 - File transfer
 - Thumbnails creation
 - Approval process
- Agenda Module (CDS Agenda)

3 – CDS Agenda

- Started 1999 ATLAS Experiment
- Now widely used
- Stores meeting time-tables ...
- ... And associated multimedia files
- 2500 Agendas
- 15000 files
- http://agenda.cern.ch

4 – Video Processing

- Seminars and conferences are recorded and webcasted
- Specific data format needs specific file server (streaming): http://webcast.cern.ch
 - RealMedia format
- Added value:
 - Link videos and transparencies together
 - Timing acquisition (automatic when using MS Powerpoint, but manual when using mere slides)



5 - INDICO

- INtegrated DIgital COnference
 - <u>http://indico.sissa.it</u>
 - EU funded project over 3 years
 - One centralized server for storing conference announcements
 - One locally installable software for managing a conference.
 - High Tech features:
 - Soundtrack indexing
 - Automatic video storyboarding
