- Policy Board (all NGIs) met 20th January in Prague.
- Approved the latest draft of the Blueprint
 - Said to be much improved
- Received 8 bids to host EGI.org, the central part of the EGI organisation.
- Elected an Evaluation Group
 - Which should give feedback by 20/2.
 - PB will vote at workshop in Catania, 2/3.









dCache Workshop Highlights

- Discussed options for T1 selfhelp because dcache.org is not avail 24/7 and has also limitations
- **Concluded** that (technical) documentation is still far from sufficient and that dedicated input from the T1s must be expected on the road to selfhelp.
 - A series of masterclasses for T1 admins will be organised.
- Not all failover/redundancy options have been activated on all sites (notably the failover of databases is not optimal)
- The WS will have a **follow-up** with tentative topics:
 - improving performance,
 - handling situations when resources are depleted (e.g. out of memory),
 - improving monitoring for experiments/users
