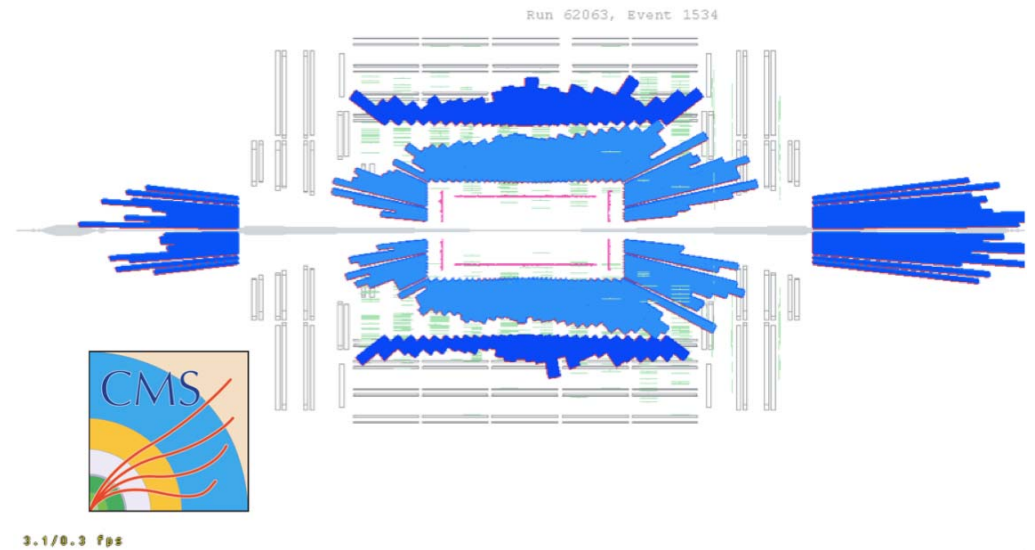
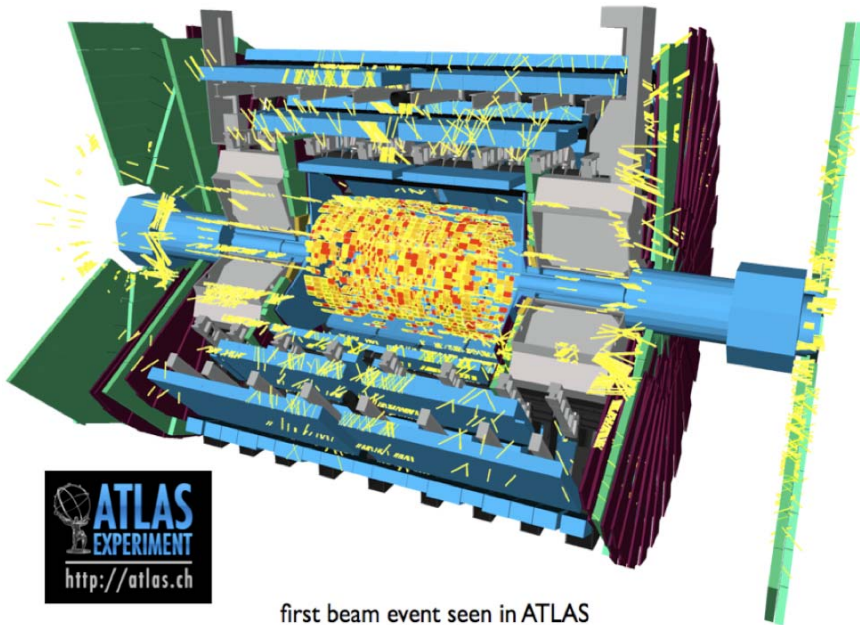

Introduction (1)

- ▶ The first ACES workshop held in March 2007 had a large attendance
 - ▶ 234 registrations and almost 200 people in each session
- ▶ One of the conclusions of this workshop was that this kind of event should happen on a regular basis and address specific sub-systems
- ▶ This second ACES is devoted to the trackers
 - ▶ A lot of work is going on
 - ▶ Common working groups or developments exist
 - ▶ Power, Links, ...

Introduction (2)

- ▶ As for the first one, it is organised in sessions
 - ▶ *System requirements*
 - ▶ *Power*
 - ▶ *Trigger*
 - ▶ *Progress on front-end systems*
 - ▶ *Hybrids and interconnects*
 - ▶ *Links*
- ▶ Presentations mainly on subjects where common features or developments are likely or where there are complementary activities in both experiments
