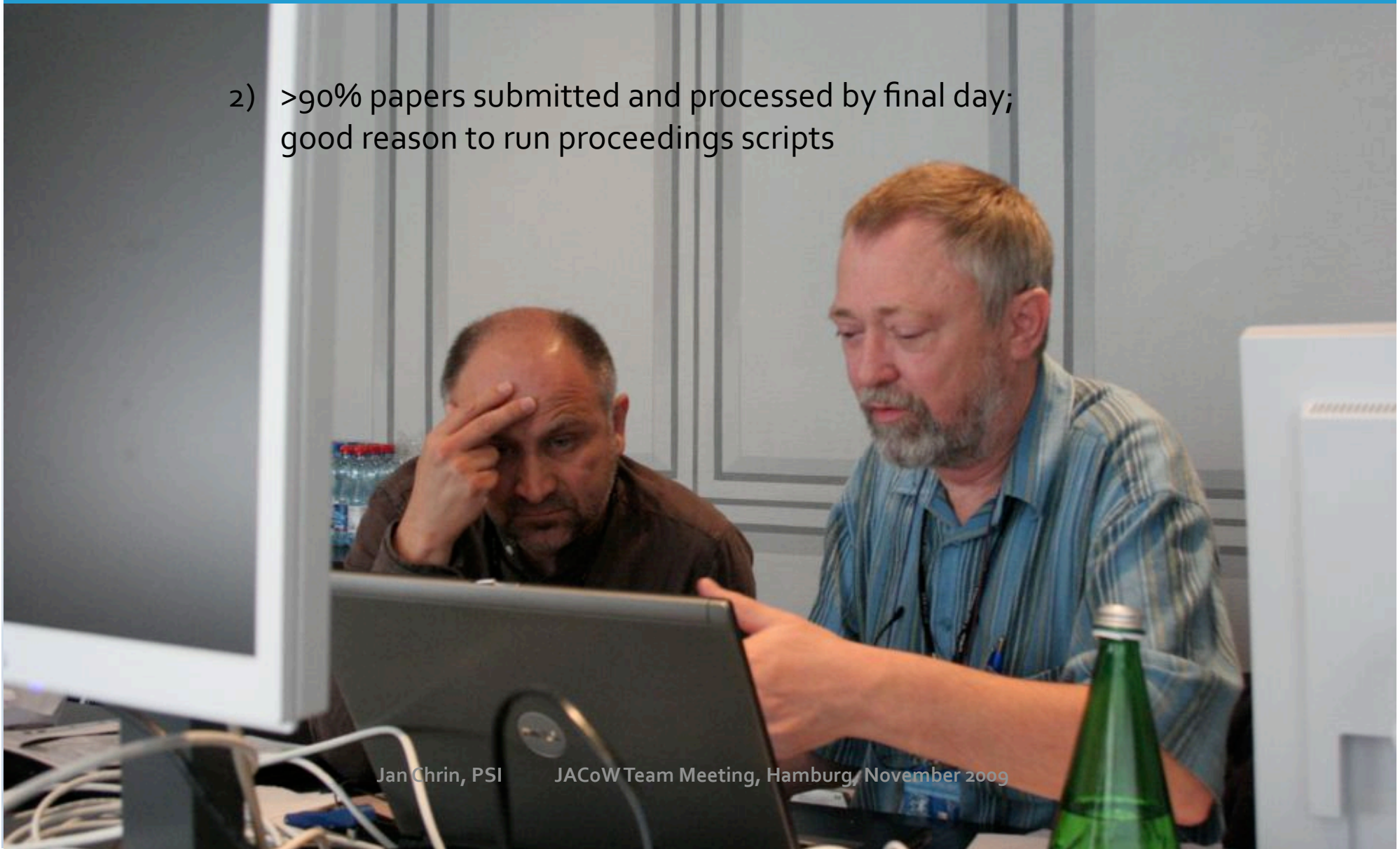
Some personal/subjective points of view

3) Keep momentum going after the event itself!
