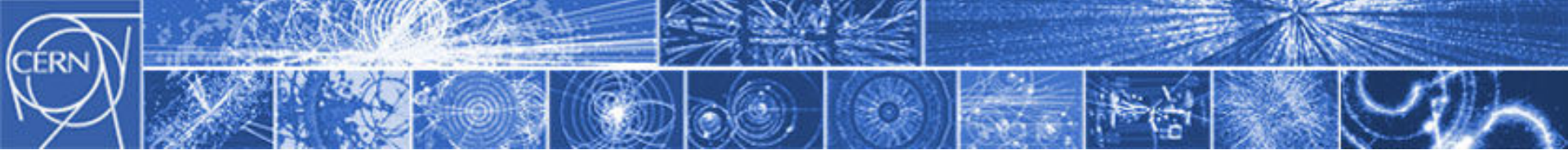
- 2006 – European strategy for particle physics, DESY Zeuthen

- 2009 – A well cemented team

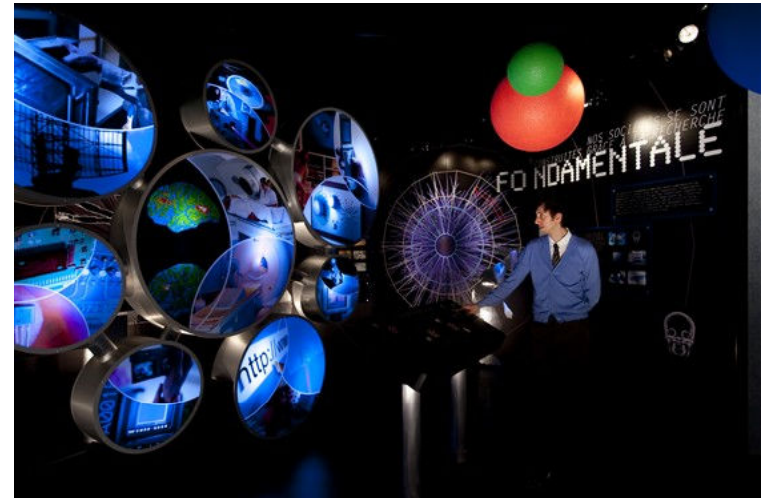


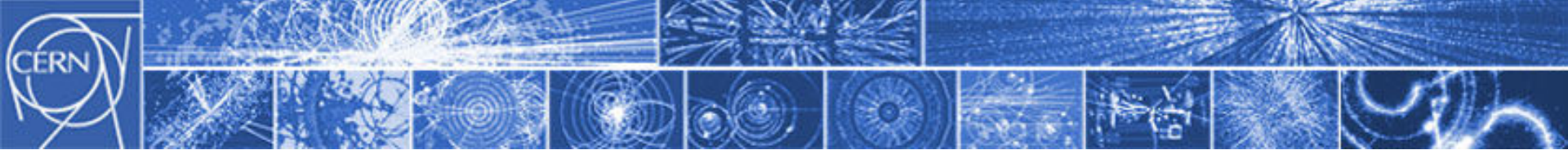


