SEE ROC in EGEE-III

- SEE ROC is:
 - Large
 - Distributed
 - Multinational (7 + 1 countries)
 - Multi-disciplinary



SEE ROC in EGEE-III

- Countries / ROC functions
 - Greece ROC Management, Core Services, Site Certification, Accounting, (Monitoring), SEE-GRID Integration Planning
 - Bulgaria ROD but ROD/1st line support is also NGI based
 - Cyprus Core Services
 - Israel Core Services
 - Romania Helpdesk
 - Serbia Operational support, interoperations with SEE-GRID
 - Turkey Operational Support
 - FYROM Not officially in EGEE-III

- 1st step, Greek NGI to become autonomous in terms of operations
- 2nd Step: Turkey and Serbia to follow (preparation in Parallel)
- 3rd Step: Bring the SEE-GRID-SCI countries that are not in EGEE-III but are in EGI to SEE-ROC
 - Albania
 - Bosnia & Herzegovina
 - Montenegro
 - Armenia
 - Georgia
- Total countries 13
- This task needs coordination as well (add new countries to OPS tools)



Plans for Greek NGI

- Assume that Greece will technically become GRNET ROC

- Greek NGI name: GRNET
- DNS Name: hellasgrid.gr
- ROC Manager, ROC Deputy, ROC Security Contact
 - Defined
- Mailing Lists planned and to be provided
- GOCDB: GRNET = new NGI = new ROC (see Assumption above)



Plans for Greek NGI

- NGI Web pages, wiki
 - already existing (small modification to reflect the new situation is needed)
- Certification Infrastructure
 - (the SEE ROC one will be used since Greece provides it)
- Nagios
 - National Nagios (nagios.hellasgrid.gr) is already in place – go through the validation test presented this morning (via ops VO)
 - Keep Regional Nagios using ops.see (probably) VO for the rest of the SEE sites



Plans for Greek NGI

Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

- Helpdesk: National Helpdesk Already in place (rt.hellasgrid.gr)
 - Needs integration with GGUS
 - Regional Helpdesk to be used in the beginning
- Core services (already existing)
- ROD Already organized (Rotation based, within country)
- Regional Dashboard
 - Rely on Central in the beginning with Regional View
 NGI View

 Mid March to be ready to switch over (Depending on generic SA1 plans) -> Probably delayed
