

Nuclear Fission Energy - today, in 2013 and thereafter?

Speaker: John Busby (UK)

From being a project manager in ICI he was appointed in 1968 as Director of the Centre for Industrial Innovation at the University of Strathclyde. In 1975, he returned to project management and a new career in the dairy industry. He built a major automated city dairy in Zurich, followed by export sales in Europe, South America and the Far and Middle East. Major projects in Venezuela, Iceland and Saudi Arabia resulted and visits to around 40 countries gave him a broad view of the world's economic and social life. As a business development manager he was active in Eastern Europe during the breakdown of communism and witnessed the problems of uncoordinated transition to capitalism and the those of the merging West and East Germany. He acted as leader and co-ordinator for the milk sector of comprehensive food supply studies undertaken for the UK Know How Fund for the Former Soviet Union in Russia and in the Ukraine. He also acted as milk industry specialist for an EU-supported private farm sector development study in the Moscow area.
