PROGRAMME

The aim of the meeting is to review and discuss the ongoing analyses and the future prospects of the ALICE Physics programme. This Physics Week will include the following sessions, from Sunday 19 May at 15:00 to Friday 24 May at 13:00:

- A session for each of our eight PWGs
- A poster session will be held during the Tuesday afternoon coffee break
- An ALICE Ideas in Motion (AIM) session, in the morning of Wednesday 22 May
- A special session, in the afternoon of Wednesday 22 May, with invited theory talks by F. Becattini (Florence University), A. Beraudo (CERN) and V. Greco (Catania University), and a lecture on Galileo Galilei by G. Peruzzi (Padova University).

An Analysis Tutorial session will be held in the afternoon of Friday 24 May.

The sessions will be held in the auditorium of the San Gaetano Cultural Centre (via Altinate 71), with the exception of the Wednesday afternoon session (Aula Magna of the University ancient building, via VIII febbraio 2) and the Analysis Tutorial (Aula "Rostagni" of the Physics Department, via Marzolo 8). The location of these venues is indicated in the map available on the web site.

The coffee breaks and lunches (Monday to Friday), which are included in the registration fee, will take place in the open space of the Cultural Centre.

The Welcome Drink will take place at the Caffè Pedrocchi on Monday 20 May at 19:00.

 The Social Dinner will take place on Wednesday 22 May, at the Villa dei Vescovi, about 20 km outside Padova, at the foothills of the Colli Euganei.

Regular and reduced fees include ten coffee breaks and the five lunches from Monday to Friday, the Welcome Drink, and the Social Dinner.

Accompanying person fee includes the Welcome Drink and the Social Dinner.

The following payment methods are accepted:

- Credit Card: VISA / MASTERCARD, Secure Socket Layer (SSL Technology) encryption will be used.
- Bank Transfer: the account coordinates are given in the payment form. It is important to indicate as subject of the transfer: Registration APW 2013 for [Your-Name Your-Surname].

Bank Transfers must be <u>free of charges for the recipient</u>. For payments by Bank Transfer, please bring a proof of payment to the registration desk.

The registration fee cannot be paid in cash.

On-site payment is only possible via credit card (VISA or MASTERCARD), and it will be made via the payment web site. It is strongly recommended to pay in advance.

WIFI NETWORK

Wifi connectivity is provided in the Auditorium of the Cultural Centre and in its premises (undergounrd floor), without registration or passwords (SSID: PADOVAwebfree). In the open space at the ground floor, where coffee breaks and lunches take place, wifi is provided with SSID: pdweek; password: apw2013pd

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Venice "Marco Polo" airport is the closest to Padova (45 km). This airport is connected to 93 international destinations, served also by some low-cost airlines. Airport site: http://www.veniceairport.it The Treviso airport, 60 km to Padova, is served mainly by low-cost airlines and it is connected to 44 international destinations. Reaching Padova from the airport

From the Venice airport:

- AIRSERVICE airport shuttle. A shuttle service can be booked to collect participants at the airport and drive them directly to their hotels. The price per person, one-way, is 29 (one person) to 23 euros (3 or more people to the same hotel). Payments are made to driver with cash or credit card. The driver will be waiting for you in front of the arrivals exit (usually close to the sliding doors), showing the ALICE logo. Booking is mandatory. In order to book this service, please complete the corresponding part of the Registration Form, before the 14th of May.
- Bus "SITA". The ticket costs 8 euros and can be bought at one of the desks located in the arrivals hall (on your left when you exit); the bus stop is located outside the arrivals hall, on the right

side of the second lane; the travel time is 1 hour and 10 minutes; get off at "Padova Autostazione", the main stop in Padova. The bus runs every 60 minutes, at HH:40 from 7:40 to 21:40 (on the way back at HH:25 from "Padova Autostazione"). The timetable is available in the APW web site.

From the Treviso airport:

- AIRSERVICE airport shuttle. See above ("From Venice airport"). The price per person, one-way, is 38 (one person) to 24 euros (3 or more people to the same hotel). Booking is mandatory.
- Bus "SITA" or "La Marca". The ticket costs about 10 euros and can be bought at the newspapers stand in the hall; the bus stop is located across the road in front of the airport, slightly on the right; the travel time is 1 hour; get off at "Padova Autostazione", the main stop in Padova. The bus runs approximately every 30 minutes. The timetable is available in the APW web site. From the bus station you can walk to the hotel (typically 20 minutes, see map), or take a taxi (about 10 euros) or a bus.

Upon arrival in Padova (bus station or train station): you can walk to your hotel (typically 20 minutes walking, check map on the web site), or take a taxi (about 10 euros) or a bus.


- From the bus station, walk 200 meters in the West direction to reach the train station.
- Taxis are available in front of the train station. Taxi telephone number: +39 049 651333 (normally not needed).
- Padova City Bus lines (orange buses) from the train station to hotels: see "Accommodation" page
 (last column of the table) in the APW web site. Tickets can be bought at the stand in the square
 in front of the train station. Ask for confirmation of the bus number and position of the stop in the
 square. Then, ask the driver which stop is best for your hotel.

DIRECTIONS AND MAPS

- The Welcome Drink will be held on Monday at 19:00 at the Caffè Pedrocchi, via VIII febbraio 15.
- The Special Session will be held on Wednesday at 14:00 at the Old University Building (il Bo), via VIII febbraio 2. The directions from Centro Culturale to both these venues are shown in map 1 below.
- The meeting point to board the busses on Wednesday is Prato Della Valle. The directions from the Old University are shown in map 2 below. The meeting time is 18:00 sharp.
- The Analysis Tutorial will be held on Friday at 14:30 in the Aula "Rostagni" at the Department of Physics and Astronomy, via Marzolo 8. The directions from Centro Culturale are shown in map 3.




