



ECCE is a Consortium

- ECCE is not yet a collaboration
 - We are very careful to distinguish it at this early stage as a “consortium”
 - The process by which ECCE becomes a collaboration is up to you
- ECCE is open to everyone
 - Shared goal is to realize the EIC science program
- ECCE is not exclusive
 - Participating in ECCE should not be interpreted as precluding participation in other efforts
- ECCE needs effort
 - Producing a proposal in a year is quite a challenge



Organization

To proceed effectively to develop a scientific proposal, we propose:

- Formation of an Institutional Board
- Formation of Working Groups around principal concentrations of activity
