### Contractual status of ARIES

### **Grant Agreement = contract with the EC**

- To be signed by the EC and CERN soon.
- Accession Forms to be signed by the other 47 beneficiaries afterwards.

# Consortium Agreement = internal agreement of the Consortium

- Final version sent out for signature: hopefully in March / April 2021
- Signed by all 48 beneficiaries, and 12 partner organisations

### **Pre-financing of 4.83 M€ = initial payment by the EC**

- To be received by Coordinator
- Individual payments to the beneficiaries will be made after the signature of the Consortium Agreement as follows:

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    70% → at the beginning of the project, subject to the signature of the CA
    30% → after the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> year, subject to the approval of the Y1 report by the GB
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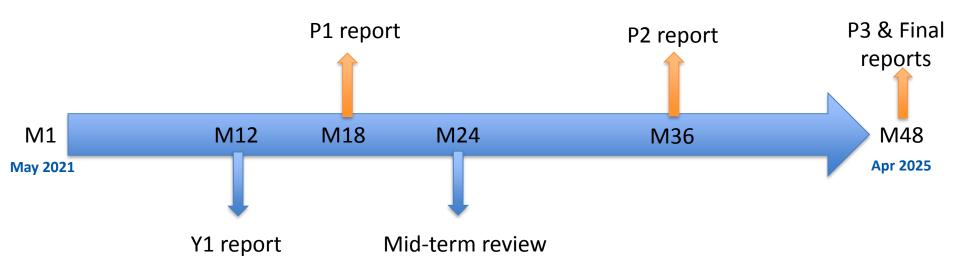
<u>Note</u>: beneficiaries with a total EC contribution of < 100,000 € → will receive the full amount of pre-financing in a single instalment at the start of the project.

## Project reporting lines

### There will be two project reporting lines in ARIES:

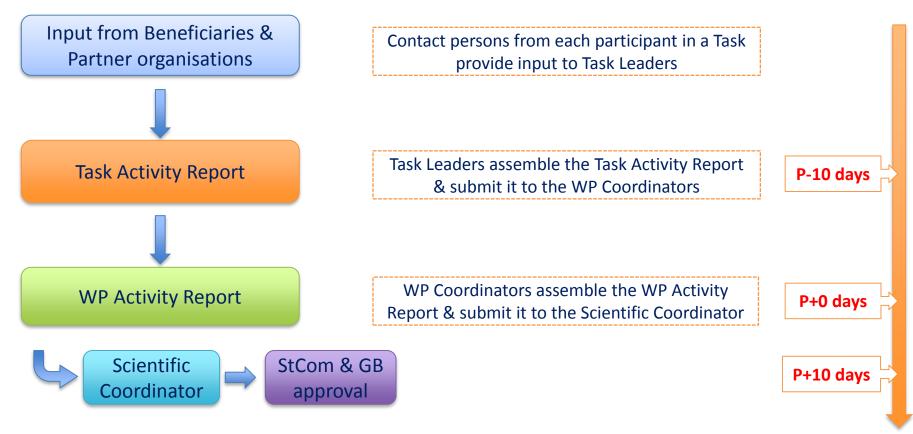
- **→** External = reporting to the EC, covering:
  - the Periodic Technical Report
  - the Financial Summaries of all beneficiaries and third parties
- → Internal = reporting to the project management, serving:
  - as necessary input for the preparation of the Periodic Reports
  - as means for the Coordinator, StCom and the GB to follow-up the technical progress and full costs of the project, and in case of problems, to take adequate measures on time, as needed

# Project reporting at M12 (Y1)

Purpose: to allow the StCom/GB to follow-up the progress in the 1st year of the project

#### **Content** (based on the template of the Periodic Reports to the EC)

- 1. A brief description of the work performed on the Tasks in Y1, achievements, problems encountered and corrective actions taken, as well as major deviations from Annex 1.
- 2. Description of progress towards Deliverables and Milestones and expected delays, if any, as well as reasons for such delays.
- 3. Plans for the work to be completed during the next year.

Length: ~4 pages/WP + pictures, tables, graphs

Periodicity: once, at M12 (April 2022)

Covers: M1-M12

### Mid-term review at M24

**Purpose**: to allow the EC Project Officer and the external reviewer to assess the progress in the first 2 years of the project (complementary to the 1<sup>st</sup> periodic report)

#### **Content** (presentations based on the content of the Periodic Reports to the EC)

- 1. A brief description of the work performed on the Tasks in M19-M24, achievements, problems encountered and corrective actions taken, as well as major deviations from Annex 1.
- 2. Description of progress towards Deliverables and Milestones and expected delays, if any, as well as reasons for such delays.

Length: 10-12 slides/WP incl. pictures, tables, graphs

Periodicity: once, at M24 (April 2023)

Covers: M1-M24

## Periodic reporting to the EC at M18,M36,M48

#### Periodic reports = official reports to the EC

→ Must be sent to the EC at the end of each reporting period (+2 months for preparation)

#### **Content**

- 1. Publishable summary
- Work performed by the beneficiaries in the WP during the period, progress towards objectives, milestones and deliverables and the main results achieved so far
- 3. Progress beyond the state of the art and expected potential impact
- 4. Overview on the use of resources during the reporting period (per WP and beneficiary)
- Deviations from Annex 1 and Annex 2
- 6. Dissemination and exploitation of results (scientific publications, dissemination and communication activities)
- 7. Critical implementation risks and mitigation actions
- 8. Gender statistics

**Length**: ~ 4 pages/WP + pictures, tables, graphs

Periodicity: at M18 (Oct 2022), M36 (Apr 2023), M48 (Apr 2025)

### Resources monitoring

#### I.FAST budget

Full costs = **18.7 M€**EC contribution = **10 M€** 

→ all partners contribute with a certain amount of matching funds and the funding rate for the beneficiaries is variable but typically 40-50%.

#### **Internal Resource Utilisation Summaries (IRUS)**

**Purpose**: to allow the Coordinator and the GB to monitor the utilisation of resources of each participant, WP and project as a whole.

**Content**: an estimate (not necessarily actual expenditure) of the full costs related to the project.

#### **Periodicity**:

- M12, M18, M36, M48 for the beneficiaries
- M12, M24, M36, M48 for the partner organisations

The IRUS summaries will NOT be sent to the EC and do not have to be formally certified.

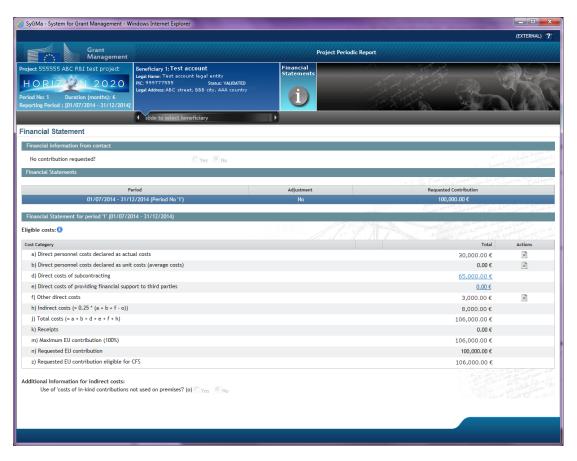

# Periodic financial reporting to the EC

**Financial Statements**: special forms on the Participant Portal where beneficiaries will report and claim to the EC their EC contribution from Annex 2 of the Grant Agreement

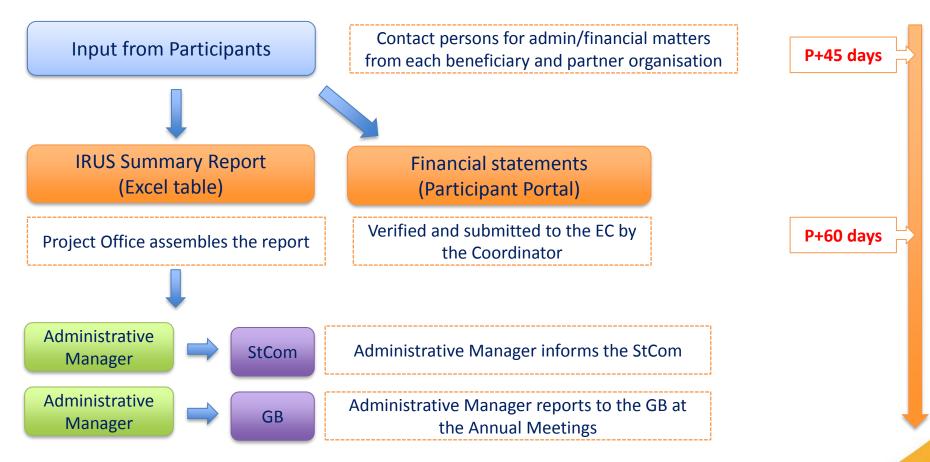


- → Each beneficiary will need to complete on the Participant Portal its Financial Statement (and the financial report of their Third Parties), including explanations on the use of resources (UoR)
- → The PDFs of the Financial
  Statements and UoR will be generated automatically by the system

Periodicity: at M18, M36, M48

P = the last day of the reporting period

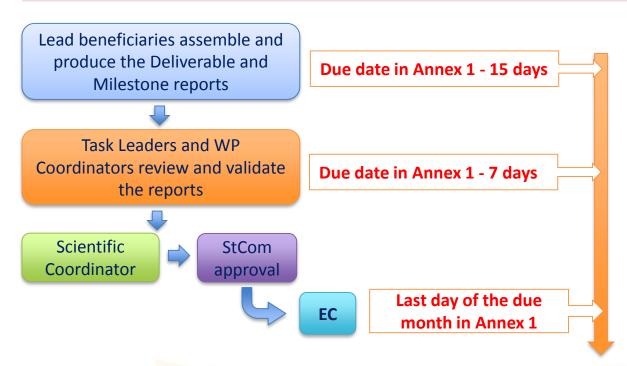


## Deliverable and milestone reports

**Deliverables** = committed contractual outputs of the project **Milestones** = checkpoints indicating the progress of the project

**N.B.** each Deliverable and Milestone has to be associated with a **written report**, regardless of their nature (website, prototype, database etc.)

**Deadlines** → the reports must be sent to the EC according to the timetable indicated in Annex 1. All delays will be flagged on the Participant Portal and will require a written justification.

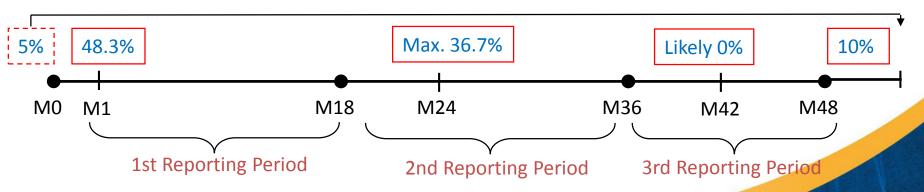
