- In the meantime some more information has been added to the PhysicsPerformance pages for a few new items:
 - for instance how to change the tracker/beam pipe dimensions or characteristics to study effects on tracking and vertexing
- Currently the simulation is done with Delphes but the output files are saved in the edm4hep format. Instructions and examples to unpack these data are available in FCCAnalysis.
 - the common usage of these edm4hep will allow the development of common tools for reconstruction and analysis that can be reused
