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CMS Standard Model Results

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The Large Hadron Collider (LHC) has completed in 2018 its second working phase and the experiments have collected data sets of proton–proton collisions at center-of-mass energies of 13 TeV with an integrated luminosity of about 140 $\rm fb^{-1}$. This report reviews the status of standard model measurements with the CMS experiment at the LHC.

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
