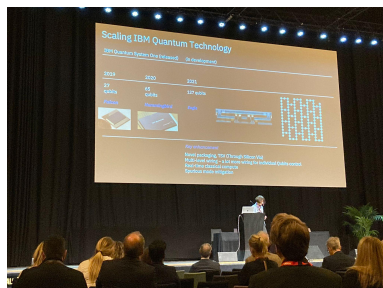


Tech Connect EUROPE
