

Health protection at the Institute of Physics during the pandemic



Please read the following instructions and regulations carefully and confirm by your signature that you have understood and taken note of everything, and that you will consistently consider and follow these instructions and regulations during your work at the Institute of Physics:

- Work in presence at the Institute is only justified if it is urgently required and can only be done on site due to the necessary infrastructure. Wherever possible, work should be done in a home office. The decision on the necessity of work in presence is the responsibility of the scientific working groups.
- The institute buildings are closed and locked to the public.
- Access to the institute with cold symptoms is prohibited.
- Regular use of the free antigen rapid tests (e.g. on campus and at the Hechtsheim fairgrounds) is strongly recommended.
- A medical mask must always be worn inside the buildings. This may only be waived by those who are permanently alone in a room separated from traffic routes and communal facilities.
- Contacts should be minimized. Several persons may only stay in the same room if at least 10 m² are available per person. The distance between two persons should always be as large as possible and must not be less than 1.50 m.
- If more than one person are in the same room, the greatest possible exchange of air should be ensured. Ideally, all existing windows should be opened completely at all times, and in very low temperatures, the room should be ventilated every 20 minutes for at least 5 minutes.
- If two or more persons meet in a room, the presence must be documented in a suitable manner and the documentation kept for 1 month. The exact procedures are to be decided by the work groups and enquired about there.
- Entering rooms in which other persons are present must be avoided as a matter of principle, unless one is explicitly requested to come in. This applies in particular to the Goods and Building Management and the Mechanical Workshop. Workshop rooms may only be entered by workshop employees; all contact by other institute employees must be made via the workshop management.
- Elevator rides (maximum occupancy: 1 person) should be avoided if possible.
- The staircases on the east side (next to the elevators) may only be used downwards, the staircase on the west side (next to the toilets) may only be used upwards.
