JGU Mainz has moved from emergency shut down into restricted standard operation today, June 7th

→ Changes ? – almost none !

Restrictions within the Institute of Physics as in all other institutions:

- Corridors and rest rooms – masks to be worn (provided if necessary by us)
- Labs: 10 m² per person required and good air circulation – distance of 2 m to be kept whenever possible
 - Larissa lab max 12 persons – air exchange 5x per hour!
 - Lunch: Lorentz room (5th floor) for rainy weather max 6 persons (no mask but max. distance, windows open)
 - One person per office
 - Health protection sheet to be signed
 - Supervisors have to keep written track of presence of persons in the lab!

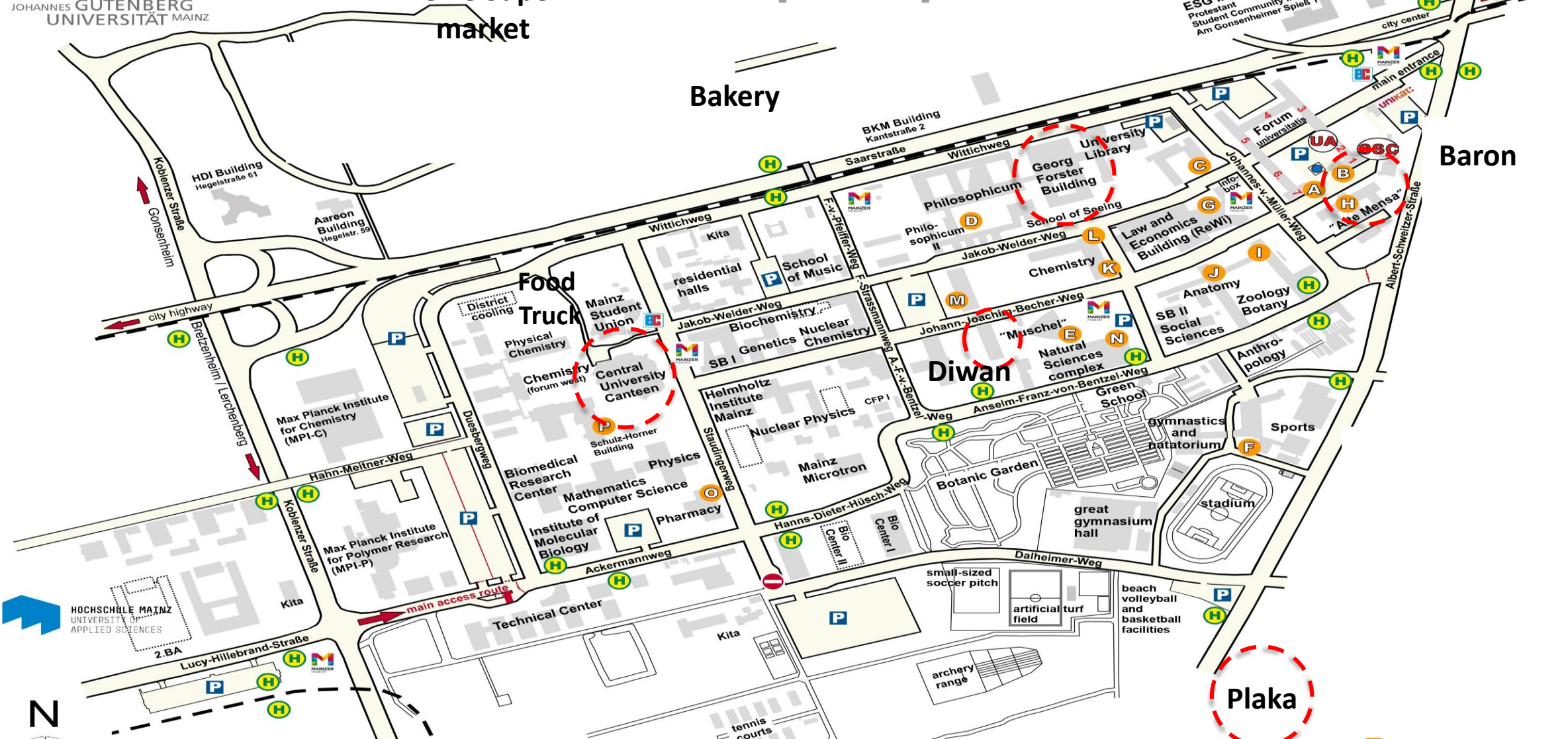
Locations at and around the Campus
