

- + One of the most advantageous employee stock options taxation benefit in Estonia (flat 20% tax)

Obtain an address and contact person in Estonia and get help defining business structure. Cost: €50-100 monthly average.

Register company in Estonia

Pay state fee for company registration and form your company's structure.

Cost €190.

Apply for business banking

Find a FinTech partner in our service provider marketplace to cover your company's banking needs.

Participate in our community

Be an active member of the e-Residency community and network globally to grow your business.


Choosing a legal entity

Private Limited Company — OÜ

- + Most popular in Estonia
- + Suitable for 1 or more shareholder companies
- + Low share capital (€2500, can be deferred)
- + Easy registration process

Contact person &legal address

- + The only mandatory local service if the management board is located in a foreign country
- + Only a licensed representative may be designated a contact person
- + The address of the contact person shall be considered the address of the company



How much will company incorporation cost?

- + State fee for company registration (OÜ): 190 euros
- + Contact person & legal address: 200-400 euros/year
- + Accounting: starting from 50 euros/month
- + Other services, business licenses




