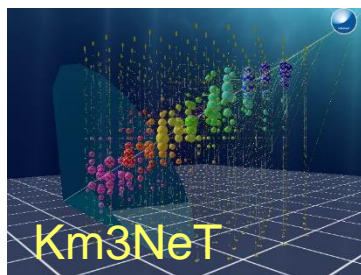
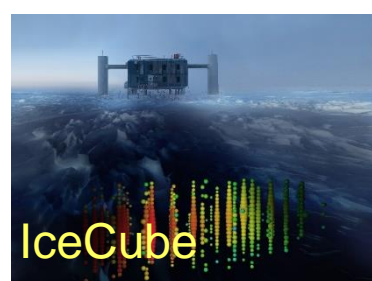
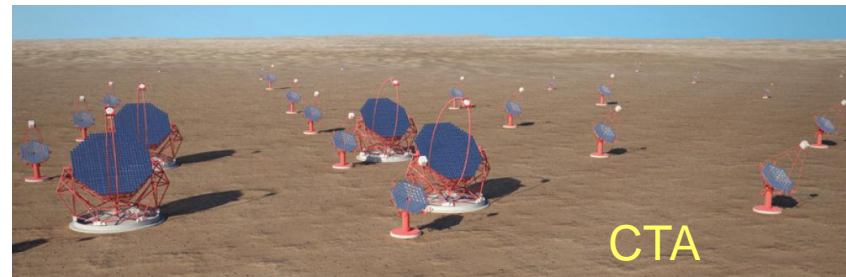
The South African Gamma-Ray Astronomy Programme (SA-GAMMA)
