



Prof. Rohini M. Godbole, currently Honorary Professor at the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, is a theoretical particle physicist. She retired from the Centre for High-Energy Physics of the IISc after serving as Professor for over 25 years. She was earlier at the Mumbai University., the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, and has also worked at a number of universities in India, Europe and the USA including at CERN, Geneva. Two century old Universities , the S.N.D. T Women's University and the Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth have conferred D.Litt. on her.

A Fellow of the World Academy of Science (TWAS), she has been elected to the three science academies of India, serving as Vice President of the Indian National Science Academy as well.
