

Ahmadou Wagué is a Professor of Physics at the Dakar Cheikh Anta Diop University, in Senegal West Africa. He is the President of African Physical Society. He is International Councillor and member of the Board of Directors at American Physical Society, member of National Academy of Science and Techniques of Senegal and vice President of international Commission for Optics.

He created in 1992 the Laboratory "Atomes Lasers", an ICTP affiliated Centre at the Department of Physics of Cheikh Anta Diop University. He was a former Director of the Institute of Applied Nuclear Technology (2003-2015) where he was involved in Nuclear Analytical instrumentation with applications in agriculture medicine, radiation protection and nuclear security. Prof. Wagué is a President and founding member of the African Laser, Atomic Molecular, and Optical Sciences Network (LAM Network).
