



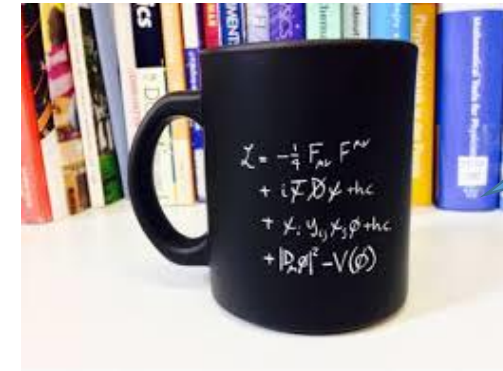

Your CERN openlab Summer Student Experience

- ◉ 9 weeks, minimum (Except QHACK winners -> 8 weeks)
- ◉ Summer student project designed for the remote format, with supervision and close contact with colleagues
- ◉ Students are expected to participate in the day-to-day activities as far as possible, 8h/day. The active hours depend on the student/supervisor preference as well as time difference.
- ◉ Summer student report; Initial draft after 4 weeks (table of content, main sections)
 - ◉ Final draft to your supervisor a week before leaving, if possible
- ◉ A 5-minute 'lightning talk' to describe your project and its outcome at the end of your stay
 - ◉ 6 and 7 of September at 16h CET
- ◉ Virtual visits to CERN
- ◉ A series of [lectures](#) about IT, computing and data management applied to HEP and other scientific domains
- ◉ CERN Webfest (More information will follow).
