Covid Information

- Sharing of offices.
- At the moment we are advised to telework.
- 2 days/week on-site is agreed without justification.
- More than 2 days/week when a supervisor deems it necessary to work on-site. The days must be worked out between supervisors and office-colleagues that maintains 1 person in the office.
- Under these conditions we can normally find a solution that keeps only 1 person per office, allowing being in the office without a mask and keeping >2m distance more easily.
- If it is necessary to be in on the same day, your supervisor should inform Alessia to try to find a solution for the office.
- We will maintain this in the **Level3-Orange** state.
- We wait for the measures to be published for **Level2-Yellow**, to understand what will be the concept in that case.
