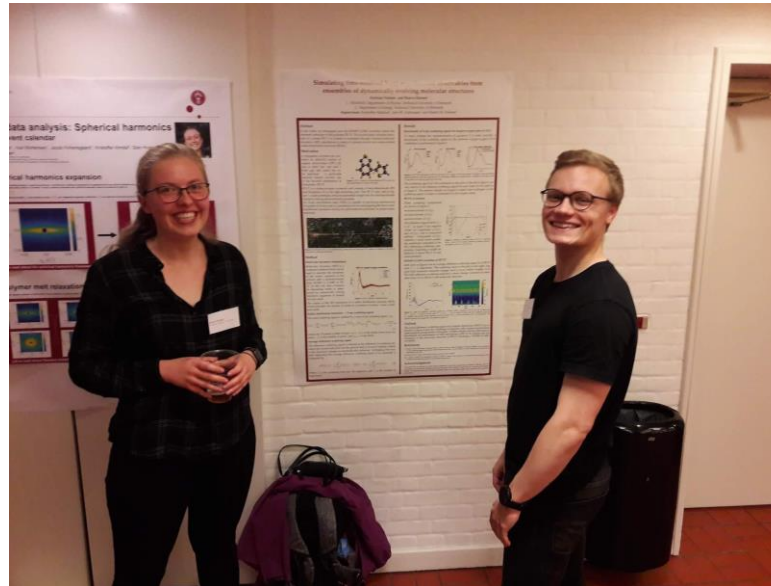

Poster session



- Idea taken over from Danish Physical Society meetings
 - “Posters and beers”: free sponsored soft drinks and beers
 - Very nice for diverse audience – encourages “stupid questions” and discussions
 - **Could be instead of PhD talks**



Plenary session

- Two parts
 - Common part: Swedish-accelerator based science
 - MAX IV, ESS, FAIR, **LHC**
 - Section-driven part:
 - Each section can nominate a speaker
 - Have to see if partikelsektionen can get two speakers or just one
 - **Plenary session could be instead of the normally invited speakers**
- Need excellent speakers that can attract participants and communicate to a broad audience (and be externally funded)



Final things
