Some words of caution

(more details in the handout)

- Avoid sunburn
 - The sun here is <u>very</u> strong!
 - Use sun cream and hats, and stay in the shade
 - Even a few minutes without protection is enough to get badly burned!

 - The pool is very nice (and safer)!
- Drink bottled water

- Phones

 - Very expensive can mean several USD per minute!
 - Also data access on roaming can be <u>extremely</u> expensive
