You can use raise-hand functionality for questions to the speakers, use mike only at after-talk question-answering session and if asked by the session Chair. ZOOM chat can be used for questions and discussions during the session.

Most sessions will be recorded and you will be asked at the beginning of each session to agree to this. We will not record question answering and discussions at the end of the talks. All the recorded talks will be posted on the Indico page for one month after the workshop to allow participants from different time zones to follow the workshop.

## Information to the Speakers Contributions

We will cover the full workshop with four different types of presentations – invited lectures, young scientist talks, contributed talks and virtual lab visits and demonstrations. We ask the speakers to upload their contribution in Indico yourself latest by the day before your presentation to avoid possible technical issues. During the session, the speakers will share their slides via ZOOM themselves and keep camera on for making the talks interactive. In case of technical problems, session chairs will help you.
