

## What Should We Do with Plenary?

- Zoom offers several options for delivery
  - "Meeting": For lectures and small meetings, up to 1,000 people
  - "Webinar": 500 ~ 50,000 people. I heard
    - This option restricts audience interactions.
    - Good for management.
    - Speaker cannot see the audience.
  - "Event": A brand new service. We do not have any experience with it yet.
    - It offers multi-track concurrent session, though.
  - Zoom pricing is reasonable and is not a problem.

## What Should We Do with Plenary?

#### Consideration

- How large is the audience? As of November 24,
   Asia 100, Europe 300, America 66, and no info 29
- A person using multiple devices (PC, tablet, cellphone) may be recognized as multiple people use.
- What does the event management company prefer?
- According to an online conference organizer, number of connected people is usually much lower than the registrants. Could be at ~ 50%.

### Covid Situation in South Korea

- The Korean government started booster shuts for elder population (50 years and up).
- The Korean government relaxed the Covid rules since November 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - The group size at restaurants has been increased to 10 in metropolitan area and 12 in other areas.
  - However, number of patients in the metropolitan area is rapidly increasing.
  - The government may go back to the tighter rule in the metropolitan area.
  - Daejeon is outside of the metropolitan area, fortunately.
- The Korean government hasn't relaxed entry rules yet.

## **Uploading Recordings**

- Zoom has the automatic recording option, which creates an MP4 file after a Zoom session.

  - It's difficult for them to create individual presentation recording in situ.
- Then we have the option of
  - 1. Uploading the full session MP4 file the next day. (LOC prefers this.)
  - 2. After the workshop, creates individual presentation videos by hiring students. Then upload them to CERN video service.
  - 3. 1 + 2.
- The quality of the videos uploaded at the CERN video service.
  - LOC and Axel tested the view quality, and found that the performance is not optimized.
