Brief Description of the Vaccination Situation in Mozambique

 Goals of our government: Vaccinate 16 million of people (Adult population) until the ends of first quarter;

Adopted Criteria

- Preferably be pre-qualified by WHO;
- Efficiency more than 60%;
- Have thermal stability of the distribution and storage conditions in the country;

To ensure the targets set were designed strategies that can be found in decree 8/2021, where the vaccination plans were designed in a way that takes into account the priority groups.

Vaccination Stages and Type of Vaccine

First Stages of Vaccination

- Started on March 8th, after we had received 200 thousand Verocell brand vaccines donated by chinese government and was vaccinated 75669 people until march 26th;
- Covers health professionals, Elderly people, diabetic patients, defense and security forces and university teachers and professors.

Second Stages of Vaccination 19/April-10/May

- Was used Covashield vaccine and covers Final year medical students, teachers who were not covered in the first stage, inmates, polices, primary school teachers;
- After this stage we received 108 thousand **AstraZeneca** vaccines and 300 thousand **Johnson&Johnson** brand, which is single dosage.

Third Stages of Vaccination 20/Oct-03/Nov

 Covers Carriers, people that were not vaccinated in the first two stages, motorcycle taxi, student and all the vulnerable people.
