DISTRIBUTION OF THE VACCINE

WHAT IS SOUTH AFRICA'S VACCINE ROLLOUT PLAN?

Along with the J&J vaccine, South Africa will be using the Pfizer-BioNtech vaccine to inoculate the population

Rollout of the vaccine will take a three-phase approach that begins with the most vulnerable in our population.

Target is to vaccinate 67% of the population by the end of 2021

- ❖ Phase 1: Focused on frontline healthcare workers
- ❖ Phase 2: Focused vaccinating essential workers, persons in congregate settings, persons over 60 years and persons over 18 years with co-morbidities.
- ❖ Phase 3: Focuses on persons older than 18 years, targeting 22,500,000 of the population.

VACCINE ROLLOUT TIME LINE

17/18 FEBRUARY 2021

- ❖ First day of Vaccination in SA where health workers are vaccinated
- ❖ The number of health care workers vaccinated under the Sisonke Protocol is 2 260 as of 6 pm 18 February 2021.

17/18 MAY 2021

- Phase two vaccination rollout started,
- ❖ A number of sector leaders aged 60 years and above came forward to be vaccinated publicly
- ❖ The total vaccinated under the Sisonke Programme is 479 768. These vaccinations were with the one-dose Johnson and Johnson vaccine and are therefore completed vaccinations
- The total vaccinated in Phase Two to date is 39 371. These vaccinations were with the first dose of Pfizer vaccine.
