




Short Paper (available 2109.10905) ~ 75 pages

- January 31 February 1: FPF4
- February 7: Final drafts of all contributions due.
- February 21: Editors return 1st complete draft to authors.
- February 28: Authors submit corrections and suggestions.
- March 7: Editors complete final draft.
- March 11: Final document submitted to Snowmass.


Plans towards Publication:

- We plan to submit the final version (without endorsers) to arXiv and a journal.




