



# IPPOG International Masterclasses 2022 The Video Conference

## Summary of main changes for 2022

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# Masterclasses, Pandemic Style

- Institutes will run their masterclasses as fully online events again this year.
  - Some students may join the video conference from school as a group.
  - Expect that most will connect from home.
- Having several hundred students on individual connections is a very different dynamic to having 4 or 5 large in-person groups (guided by an experienced person) join the video conference.
  - Moderators will also be connected remotely instead of sitting in a room together at CERN.
- **In response to this, the video conference format is changed significantly compared to previous years.**
- We welcome any feedback about what worked and what didn't, and may update the format as we gain experience with this new format.

# Summary of Main Changes

- Video conference will be run as a **Zoom webinar**.
  - Students need to request permission to unmute.
  - Moderators will have co-host permissions.
- **Zoom polls** (+ moderator discussion) will replace the questions to institutes for the welcome/icebreaker, and for the discussion and combination of results.
  - Poll question: "Can you see a peak corresponding to the Higgs boson?" (Yes/No)
  - Moderators then briefly discuss statistical limitations of the result ("we'd need more data to say for sure").
- Two options for students to ask questions in Q&A session:
  - Students write questions in **Zoom Q&A**. Questions can be 'upvoted' by other students. Questions read out by one of the moderators.
  - Students can '**raise hand**' and ask their question in person.
- Quiz will be run using **Kahoot**
  - Interactive interface, shows breakdown of answers for each round.

# Other Changes for Moderators

- Wherever possible, a **third moderator** will be assigned to each video conference.
- Suggest that one of the moderators takes on a more technical role and is responsible for:
  - Share screen/applications.
  - Monitor chat box for questions and read out to moderators.
  - Run Zoom polls.
  - Mute/unmute participants.
- Decide with your co-moderators in advance or during the setup time who will be responsible for which tasks.

# Other Changes for Moderators

- **Asynchronous training** for moderators - watch when it's convenient for you.
  - Drop in during '**office hours**' if you have questions (or want to check your audio/video setup).

    - Tuesday 22nd February 16:00 - 17:00
    - Stay tuned for future dates!
