Hybrid poster session - test

Small team incl Lucia and Axel tried this out

Tested: poster presented face-to-face, with a laptop allowing remote participants to engage with the poster presentation at the same time.

Laptop microphones cannot separate environment "noise" from the poster presenter, other presenter speaking close by keeps microphone "open", prevents to hear the remote participant. Very hard to focus on questions from the laptop speakers if discussions for another poster close by.

Hybrid poster session - recommendation (1)

Two face-to-face poster sessions, each with 50% of the posters.

Two more sessions, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, where the same posters are presented through Gather.Town, i.e. only virtually.

Hybrid poster session - recommendation (2)

No need to print / bring posters: presenters might stand next to their poster's title, allowing the audience present in Bari to 'browse' the available posters outside Indico, in a meeting room, by looking at the available titles.

Next to the title could be a QR code giving access to the poster. For attendees without a mobile phone / tablet, the poster presenter will be able to show their poster on their laptop. This worked reasonable well in our tests.
