Arrival time and transport

Registration for the CSC 2022 will take place at Hotel **Novotel Krakow City West** ([map](#)), on Sunday 4th September, afternoon from 3pm to 7pm.

Transport from Kraków airport to the hotel:

TAXI

- Kraków Airport Taxi service cost is 69 PLN (14.5 €): https://krktaxi.pl/#taxi_rezerwacje

- Uber costs around 35-45 PLN (7.5-10 €).

The ride should take ~20 minutes (or more, if heavy traffic).

BUS/TRAIN

You will be accommodated in a twin (shared) room or in a single room.

Tap water in the rooms is drinkable. Additionally, there is a bar at the hotel, where you can buy drinks and coffee (at your own cost). Breakfasts and most of the dinners will be provided at the hotel. Some dinners will be offsite during special days, this will be noted in the Schedule and announced on the day.

Classes

Lectures and exercises will take place at [AGH](#) institute, which is about 1.4km away from the hotel. It takes 15-20 minutes of walk to get there. Alternatively, there is a public bus service running every few minutes. We plan to provide bus tickets for the participants.

Computers/personal laptops - installing the VM During CSC 2022 you will be required to use your personal laptop to run the exercises. Detailed instructions will be published on CSC 2022 web site in advance.

Be prepared to use wireless network connections during the school. There will be limited to no wired network connections. **Power plug adapter needed in Poland**, have a look at: [Power plug standard in Poland](#).

Study and sports time

On most afternoons, you will have some free time. This free time may be devoted to studying, discussions with lecturers, sports activities, or organized visits.
