Mandate of the GDB



- Platform for the (T0/1/2/3) sites to discuss grid services deployment among each other, with software developers, with other service providers and the experiments
- National representation, i.e. 1 member/country but this is only used to vote for a new chairperson
- Open meeting where there is sufficient time to discuss technical details of any pressing subject
- Decisions made are endorsed by the MB
- Meeting frequency is once a month (generally first Wednesday of the month) for a whole day
- Often a pre-GDB meeting is organized to go in even more detail for several hours on one single subject

- December 5


