Mission of the LIU Project

To propose and implement the means for:

- Allowing LHC & HL-LHC to reach their maximum potential for physics,
- Ensuring a reliable operation of the LHC for physics until the end of its life (≥ 2030 taking into account possibilities of LHeC & HE-LHC...),
- A proper use of important resources (> 150 MCHF material budget and > 300 man.years) with unavoidable interferences with other priorities of the organization

Phases of the LIU Project:

- 1) Analysis (2008 - 2013)
- 2) Design / proposal (2011 – 2013)
- 3) Implementation (2013 – 2016)
- 4) Commissioning (2017)
