- The Italian program will take place between May 22 and June 4.
- We received 498 applications!
- The students have been selected, and the teacher selection is in progress.

Beamline for Schools A Physics Competition for High-School Students


After the long shutdown the competition is back to the T9 beamline of the PS accelerator at CERN.




Two new support scientists will join our team on April 1:

387 teams pre-registered to the competition.




We already organised 4 online events for the perspective participants. The next one is tomorrow.
