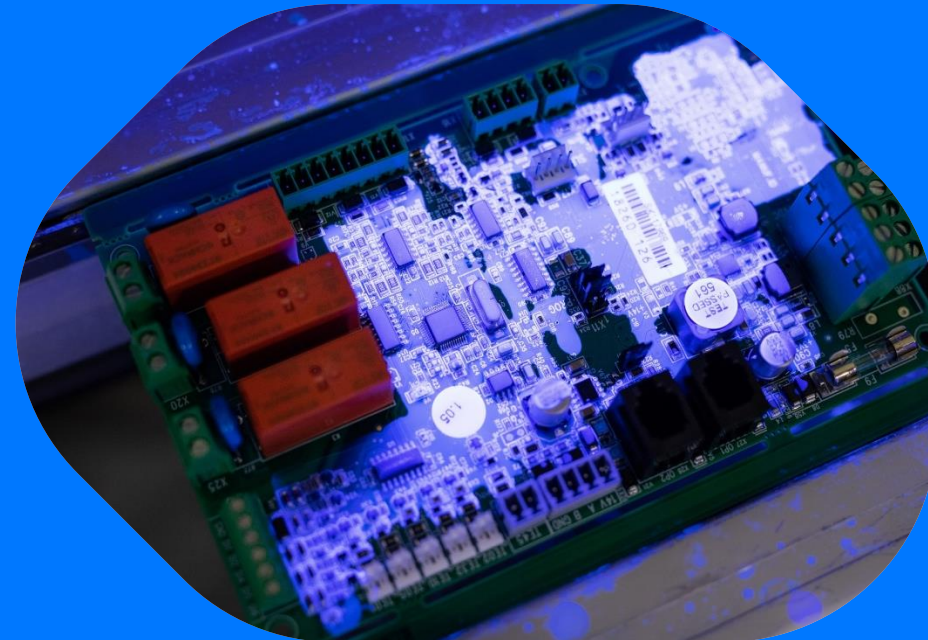

We are in stage 5. As of last week, CERN has created a company selection; the table has been forwarded to ILO-s.

- **The event is scheduled for 25-29. April**
- **The roadshow will begin in Tallinn (as agreed in discussions) and proceed from north to south**
- **Three format-related considerations:**
 - Inviting universities and start-ups along on the Roadshow in order to engage research and utilize travel time
 - Arranging a conference/matchmaking format for IT companies as opposed to visiting them
 - ILO-s are expected to participate in the entire event
- **Regarding company selection:**
 - Company preselection was made based on preparatory material sent by CERN procurement dept.
 - 40-60 companies per country in preselection; around 10 to be chosen per country
 - Companies were not contacted during preselection stage
- **Ceremonies and formalities as of yet untouched**
 - Greetings, dinners, etc
 - Size of delegations unclear today
