2011 Global Expansion to IPPOG

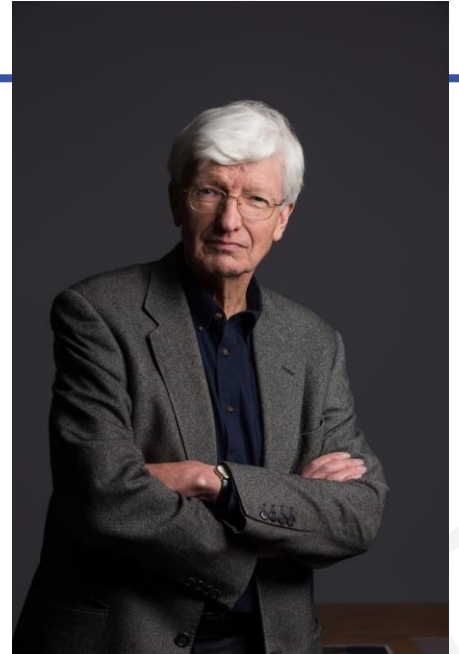
- Israel, Australia, USA, South Africa, Brazil, India, Mexico,...
