We are pleased to inform you that the 2022 edition of the **QCD@LHC conference** will take place at IJCLab **Orsay**, France in the campus of Paris-Saclay University between **28th November** and **2nd December 2022**. This will be an **in-person event only** and the registration and call for abstracts will open on 3rd August 2022 on:

The **deadline for abstract submissions** is **10th September 2022**, and for general **registration**, **7th November 2022**.

The full conference fee (300€ if paid before 7th October 2022; 375€ otherwise) includes access to all the sessions, all the lunches and coffee breaks, a boat trip on the Seine in Paris and a welcome cocktail with an art performance.

The conference dinner will be held in Musée d'Orsay in Paris (incl. visit of the museum) and will cost 50€.

Participants should arrange their own accommodation. We have listed on the Indico page a wide range of hotels in Orsay, Bures sur Yvette, Palaiseau and Massy, as we do not recommend to stay in Paris. The venue is accessible via the RER B line (direct from CDG airport and close to ORY airport, BVA is not recommended).
