- ECFA review panel for: future large infrastructures for neutrino oscillation experiments established by ECFA during its plenary meeting in July 2010. Chair and membership endorsed during the plenary meeting in November 2010, Review meeting at STFC Daresbury on 5-6 May 2011
- Kickoff meeting for the European strategy update on 23<sup>rd</sup> of July in Grenoble: three topical talks (energy frontier, neutrino and theory) and ample time for discussion
- Strategy update by December 2012

- Remark on the panel activities
  - The report will be public and a summary will be communicated to CERN Council
  - The main objective of the panel is to review the two documents and not to propose a plan or vision on neutrino activities
    - limited scope, and in the European level  
e.g. Super beam: only the CERN-Frejus option
  - Future continuation of the panel activities, still to be decided



- **European Strategy Update (I)**
  - Preparatory group who prepares scientific inputs and Working Group to prepare the update document.
  - An “Orsay” type community meeting prepared by the Preparatory Group
  - A “Zeuten” type Working Group meeting to produce a draft document for strategy update (May be more of the WG meetings)
  - Special session of CERN Council meeting, possibly in Brussels, to discuss and endorse the draft.



- **European Strategy Update (II)**
  - Preparatory Group includes, 4 from SPC, 4 from ECFA, European Strategy Secretariat (ECFA Chair, SPC Chair, National Laboratory Group chair, Scientific Secretary of European Strategy Session of Council), one Asian and American representative each, Chaired by SSESC
  - Preparatory Group will call for scientific inputs from the community
  - Neutrino community is certainly more than welcome to contribute.
