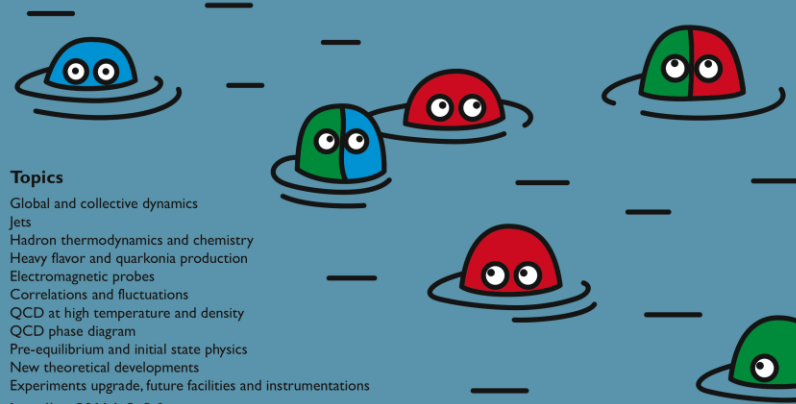

- Total budget of the order of 400K€ for 700 participants
 - Income and spending so far balanced
 - Main cost: conference venue + lunch
 - Main income: conference fees
 - * 400€ for early registration (lunch, coffee break, conference dinner, proceedings, social event)
 - * 500€ for late registration (50€ discount if conference dinner sold out)
 - * 100 students supported

* **Budget**

- ❑ The main sponsors are: CNRS/IN2P3, CERN, HIC for FAIR, CEA, EMMI, IUPAP, Journal of Physics G, BNL, ORNL, LBNL, CCNU, local administrations,...
- Several contributions are ear marked to support national or less favored countries students
- Little support available to support travel of students
- A local committee will select the supported students based on the letters of recommendation and sponsors requirements

***Sponsors**

- WIFI or not WIFI
 - WIFI will be available at the Imperial Palace
 - The cost to equip the Theatre is quite high (about 50K€), two solutions still under discussion
 - Alternative
 - * WIFI-free plenary sessions
 - * Affordable individual solutions available (3G USB stick)
 - * Spend the money to support students (lodging, travel)

* Issue

- Published by Journal of Physics G
 - Publication costs offset by grant from J.Phys.G
 - Timely publication in the interest of all !

To this end:

- * Deadline for submission 3 weeks after conference (20 June)
- * Invitation letter to speaker will ask to decline invitation if speaker cannot make firm commitment to deadline
- * To maintain deadline, we'll be prepared to give up on some late submissions
- * Clearly, these rules will be applied with common sense, but general rule will be to rank timeliness higher than completeness of proceedings volume.

*** Proceedings**

- 4 sessions in parallel in the afternoons
 - Mo, Tu, Th and Fr. afternoons from 15:00-17:00
 - * Mo & Fr also from 17:30 - 19:00 (a total of 11 hours)
 - * Tu & Th poster session from 17:00 - 19:00
 - Duration of parallel talks: 15+5 min
 - This makes 132 talks
 - Sessions will be organized according to the main topics of conference: 1. Global and collective dynamics, 2. jets,

* Parallel Sessions

- ❑ Selection of parallel talks: alternatives
- ❑ EITHER: all IAC members vote on all (> 300 ...) abstracts
- ❑ OR: 3 groups of IAC members vote on 1/3rd of all abstracts
 - less work load = more focused input ?
