About Thailand

- Area: 513,120 square kilometres
- Population: 66 million
- Time: GMT+7 hrs
- Language: Thai; English is widely understood in Bangkok and tourist provinces
- Climate: A tropical climate hot&dry, rainy, cool average temp. 20 – 35 oC
- People: 80% Thai, 10% Chinese, 3% Malay, etc.
- Religion: 95% (Buddhism), 4% (Muslim), 1% (others)
- Electricity: 220 volt AC (50 cycles)

Chulalongkorn University



- Thailand's oldest, and most prestigious university, founded in 1917
- Located in Bangkok downtown over Accommodation, top sights and shopping facilities are in the vicinity



Two international airports of Bangkok

- Suvarnabhumi International Airport (BKK): Several direct and 1-stop flight
 - Europe: London, Paris, Brussels, Zurich, Milan, Amsterdam, Vienna, Frankfurt, Moscow, Helsinki, Oslo, Copenhagen, Rome, Geneva
 - North/South America: Major cities
 - Africa: Cairo, Major cities
 - Asia: Beijing, Delhi, Mumbai, Tokyo, Seoul, Kuala Lumpur
 - Australia/New Zealand: Melbourne, Sydney, Perth, Auckland
- Don Mueang International Airport (DMK): 6th oldest airport in the world Budget airlines to several asian cities including Tokyo, Osaka, Seoul, Beijing, Taipei, Singapore

From both airports, the airport links can be used to connect to Bangkok metro system. The distance from the conference venue is ~30 km. The taxi cost is less than 10 euro.


Entering to Thailand is very easy

The **VISA ON ARRIVAL** allows passport holders of **19 countries** (*) to enter Thailand. You must have confirmed return ticket to show that they are flying out of Thailand within 15 days of entry.
