
We hope this leads to new connections and collaborations, and the sharpening of ideas about how phenomenological and experimental effort can advance our fundamental theories of causation



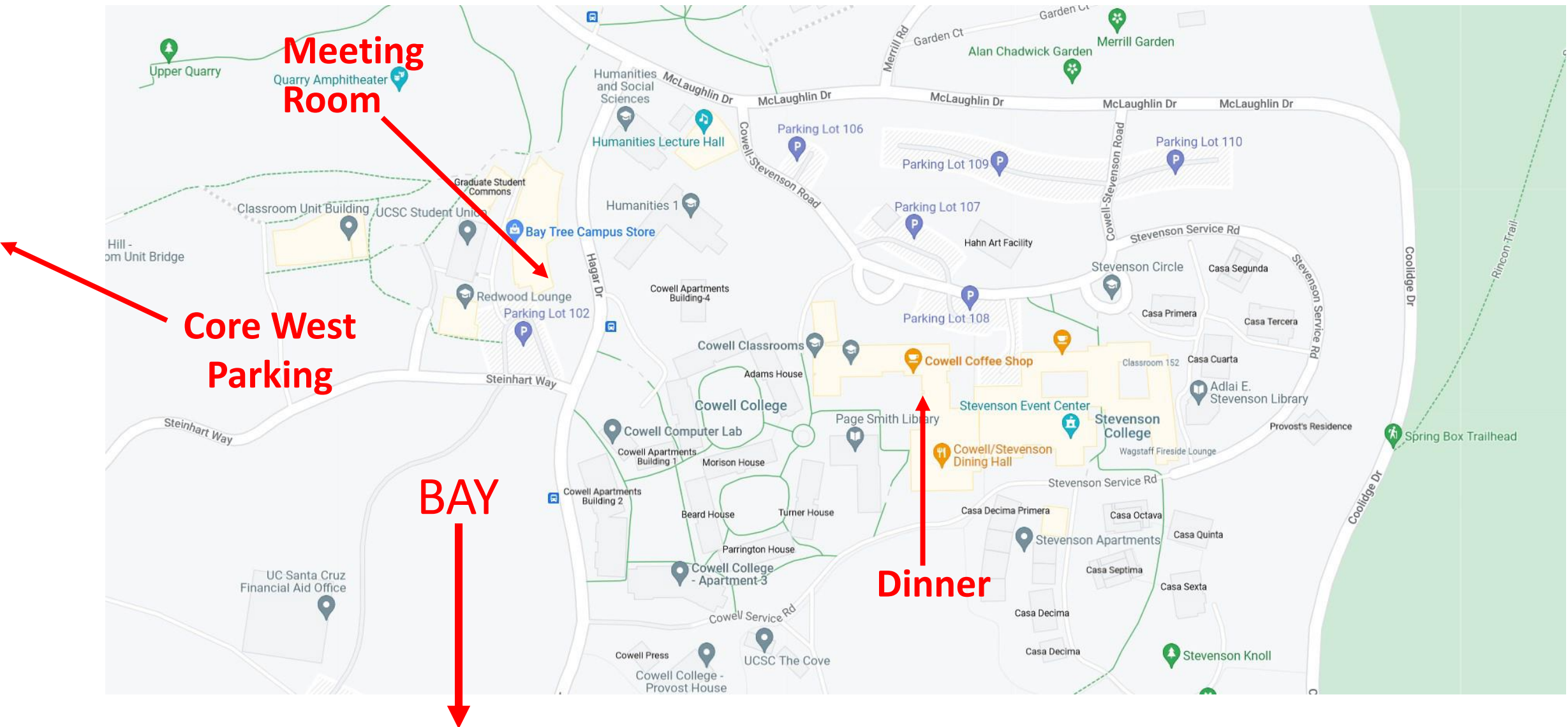
