

The Venue




- A few general remarks

 - Use <u>CERN Maps</u> (eg via mobile application) to get around








- Connection details have been distributed via email to remote attendees

- I have not attended one of these PV traditions before... ...but the title lets me expect something unexpected












The Tours

 - meet your guides after the session end close to the top of the stairs








The Tapes

 - try the CERN Open Data Portal






The Catering
