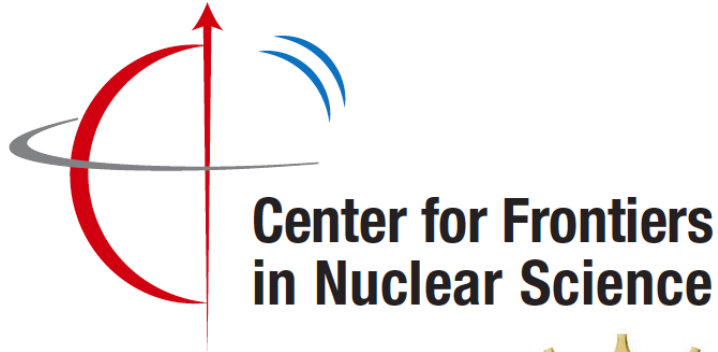

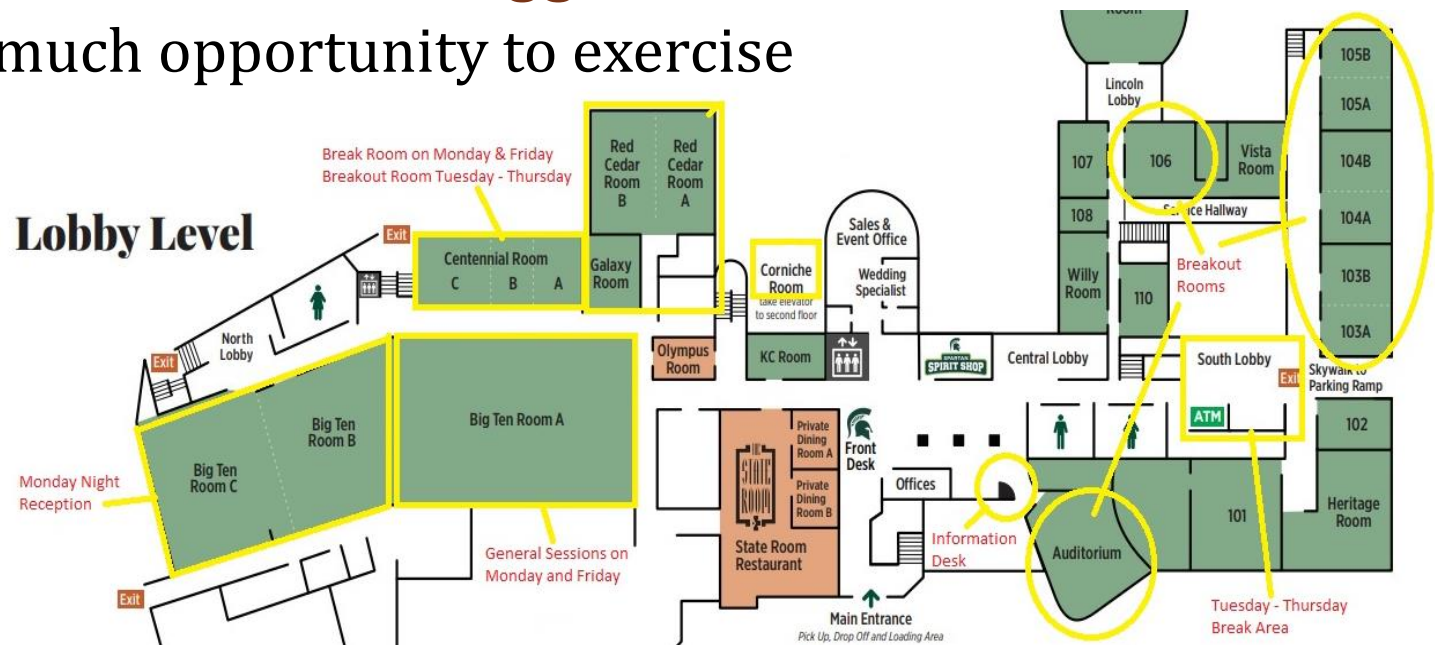

§ All sessions are within Kellogg

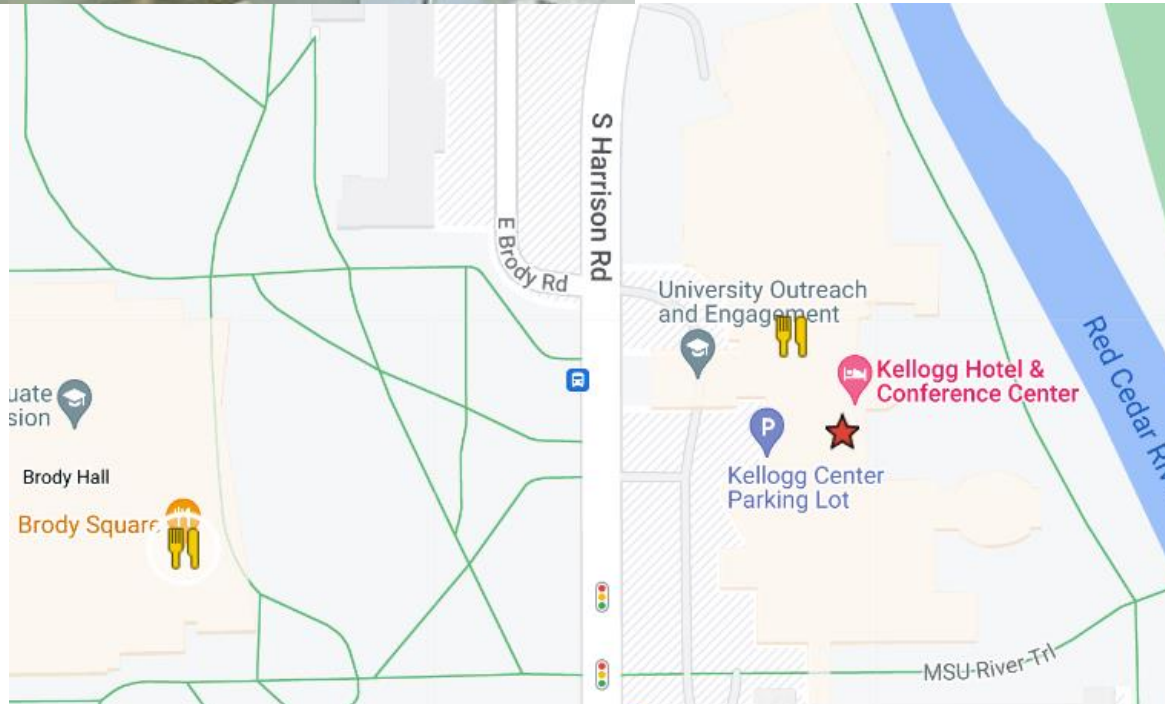
