

Tradition of higher education in Košice



- 26th of February 1657 – foundation of an Academy by the Memorandum of „*Studium Universale*“ by the **bishop Benedictus Kisdý**
- 6th of August 1660 - Golden Bull issued by the Roman emperor **Leopold I.**
- it granted the University the same privileges as to all the other universities of the Habsburg Monarchy

Reestablishment of classical university in Košice



- „*Law Academy*” - the last remainder of **„Universitas Cassoviensis”** definitely closed in 1921
- 1959 - reopening of classical university named **Pavol Jozef Šafárik University**
