Status of the measurement campaign (Gonzalo Menendez Borge)

Gonzalo summarized the latest results. Nearly all sites have stopped this week with CERN servers still running last week. There are some sites with missing measurements that could run HS32 if they wish. The success rate is >99% (some failures due to low RAM). Gonzalo noted that production measurements will have a different tag.
